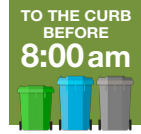

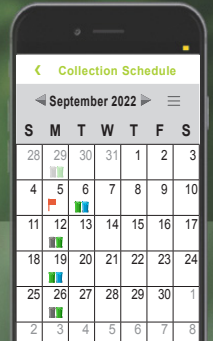

CURBSIDE COLLECTION 2024 GUIDELINES



ALL MATERIALS: GARBAGE, RECYCLING & ORGANICS

TO THE CURB BEFORE 8:00 am



All materials must be at the curbside by 8:00 am on the designated collection day.

Please note that carts/bags containing unacceptable materials will not be collected. The stickers on your cart are an attempt to raise awareness of contaminants in your cart.

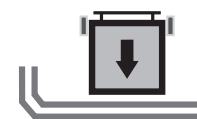
Garbage Collection

- Curbside garbage is collected **alternating weeks** with recycling collection.
- Garbage is limited to one 240 litre cart per household every second week.
- If necessary for extra refuse a, "Garbage Tags" are available for **\$2.00** each at any City office. The maximum weight of additional tagged refuse is 22kgs (50lbs) per **bag**.
- Large items can be taken to the Thornhill Transfer Station such as furniture, mattresses, electronics and liquids...
- No commercial waste, construction material in garbage or recycling
- Cat litter, animal excrement, sawdust, cold ashes, broken glass, and wet refuse must be thoroughly drained, and wrapped in paper or plastic before being placed in the cart.

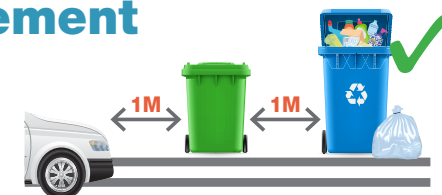
Collection Day Cart Placement

Oops!

- **Don't** Bag your recyclables in your cart
- **Do** place your recyclables **loose** in the cart
- **Additional** recyclables shall be placed in clear plastic bags **beside** cart

Carts must be at curbside, within 1 metre (3 feet) of the travelled portion of the road. Position cart with arrows pointing to centre of road with at least **1 metre** clearance around the cart as shown.

Recycling Collection

- Curbside recycling is collected **alternating weeks** with garbage collection. Please visit www.terrace.ca/refuse or www.recyclebc.ca for a detailed list of acceptable materials at the curbside and at the depot.
- There is no limit to recycling placed at curbside, but collection is restricted to recycling materials from the residence.
- Recycling materials should be placed **loosely / directly** in the cart, **not in bags**. Additional materials shall be placed in transparent (clear) **plastic bags beside** the cart once your cart is full.
- Glass, Styrofoam, plastic bags, and overwrap are not accepted in curbside recycling. These items can be taken to the local Recycle BC Depot, "Do Your Part Recycling" located at 3467 Hwy 16 East.
- **All cardboard must be flattened and cut to 30"x30" or less both in and out of the cart.** Additional cardboard must be flattened, cut/folded, and tied in bundles no larger than **8" thick x 30" wide x 30" tall** and placed beside recycling cart for pick up.
- If we find unaccepted materials in your recycling cart, your recycling may not get collected. Please remove any unaccepted materials so we can pick up your recycling cart next time.

Recycling Collection



- Recycling materials should be placed loosely/directly in the cart.
- Only put out acceptable materials for curbside collection.
- If we find unaccepted materials in your recycling cart, your recycling may not get collected. Please remove any unaccepted materials so we can pick up your recycling cart next time.

ACCEPTED MATERIAL EXAMPLES

CLEAN CONTAINERS

- Plastic trays and clamshells
- Plastic bottles, jars and jugs
- Caps, tops, lids and pumps
- Plastic or paper take-out cups, bowls, and lids
- Cartons of milk, soup, etc.
- Foil wrap and take-out containers
- Metal cans
- Empty Aerosol cans (no paints or lubricants)
- Plastic garden pots and seeding trays

PAPER

- Paper egg cartons & rolls
- Paper bags
- Shredded paper (contained in paper bag in the cart)
- Envelopes
- Household paper
- Magazines, catalogues, phone books
- Newspapers, inserts, flyers

Refundable materials are NOT returnable at curbside pickup or Recycling Depot drop-off!

All Cardboard must be CUT DOWN

Corrugated cardboard boxes (8" thick x 30" wide x 30" tall beside cart and 30x30 in cart)

- ✓ Hard plastic packaging for toys and other household items
 - ✓ Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, coffee, etc.
 - ✓ Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.
 - ✓ Plastic pails less than 25L for laundry detergent, etc.
 - ✓ Paper carry-out beverage trays
 - ✓ Cores from paper towel and toilet tissue
 - ✓ Paper bags for flour, sugar, etc.
- REMEMBER:**
- ✓ Empty and rinse containers, labels OK
 - ✓ Remove caps, pumps and lids, place loose in cart
 - ✓ Put metal lids inside cans and squeeze tightly

NOT ACCEPTED
Do NOT place in curbside recycling

NO BUILDING MATERIALS
2x4's/wood, lumber, drywall, pvc, siding...

Refundable items must be returned to Bottle Depot, refunding business or donate to a charity or cause of choice!

- NO Building materials (2x4's/wood, lumber, drywall, pvc, siding...)
- NO Foam packaging
- NO Toys and games
- NO Rocks, soil, or sod
- NO Hard and soft cover books
- NO Paper towels, napkins and tissues
- NO Glass
- NO Electronics and appliances
- NO Plastic bags and overwrap
- NO Hazardous waste (needles, flammable/explosive/toxic material etc.)
- NO Hangers, pots, pans, and other scrap metal

Organics Collection

- Curbside organics is collected on a weekly basis on the same day as garbage or recycling collection.
- Organics is limited to one 120 litre cart or one 240 litre cart per household every week.
- If you only have a small amount of organics please help our crews work efficiently and consider setting your green organics cart out on GARBAGE weeks only.
- If we find unaccepted materials in your organics cart, your food scraps and yard waste may not get collected. Please remove any unaccepted materials so we can pick up your organics cart next time.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS

Food Scraps

- Noodles, rice, beans, grains, and bread
- Meat, bones, fish, and seafood shells
- Dairy products, including cheese and yogurt
- Small amounts of oil and fat (soaked in paper towel or newspaper)
- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Egg shells

Food-soiled paper products

- Empty cereal boxes (no plastic liners)
- Pizza boxes
- Paper napkins
- Newspaper (for wrapping food scraps or lining kitchen containers)
- Used paper dishes (no plastic coating)
- Paper bags (for lining kitchen containers, such as Bag-to-Earth)
- Tissue paper (no blood or fecal matter)
- Coffee grounds, teabags, and filters
- Parchment and wax paper

Yard trimmings

- Leaves and grass clippings
- Short branches and prunings (under 10 cm thick and 50 cm long)
- Weeds, plants, and flowers

Approved bags must display one of the following logos:

Refundable materials are NOT returnable at curbside pickup or Recycling Depot drop-off!

- ✗ Blue or pink foam insulation, packing chips, or peanuts

Refundable items must be returned to Bottle Depot, refunding business or donate to a charity or cause of choice!

NOT ACCEPTED
Do NOT place in organics collection

Fecal matter

- Animal waste
- Diapers

Large or heavy items

- Branches or prunings over 10 cm thick and 50 cm long
- NO BUILDING MATERIALS 2x4's/wood, lumber, drywall, pvc, siding...

Plastics

- Biodegradable plastic bags
- Plastic bags, wrap, or containers
- Products made of Polylactic Acid (PLA) (containers, disposable plates, cutlery)

Yard Waste Drop Off



YARD WASTE DROP WILL RUN FROM THE 2ND MONDAY IN APRIL TO THE 3RD MONDAY IN NOVEMBER AT 5003 GRAHAM BETWEEN 8:30AM-4:00PM

Additional Saturdays will also be available in the Spring and Fall for extra yard waste drop off (dates TBA).

- Yard waste is composted at the City works yard and is used in City parks and boulevard projects.
- Small branches less than 12 mm (1/2 inch) in diameter and less than 1 metre (3 feet) in length are acceptable.
- There is no bag limit on yard waste collection, but maximum weight per bag should not exceed 22kgs (50lbs).

- ✗ NO cooked food, oil, meat, fish, bones, animal waste, and household refuse accepted in curbside yard waste drop off.
- ✗ NO BUILDING MATERIALS 2x4's/wood, lumber, drywall, siding...

DROP-OFF YARD WASTE IS LIMITED TO GRASS CLIPPINGS, BRANCHES AND LEAVES ONLY. NO MEAT OR FOOD SCRAPES. (PLEASE SAVE THAT FOR CURBSIDE ORGANICS PICKUP)
