# Crime Reduction Unit

## What we do

- Conduct investigations and enforcing provisions of the Criminal Code, federal and provincial statutes (ie. Motor Vehicle Act, Liquor Control and Licensing Act and Cannabis Control and Licensing Act) and, where applicable, municipal bylaws and unique statutes designed to help reduce crime.
- Liaise with alternative agencies to help find solutions to recurring issues, problem areas or prolific individuals causing resource drains on policing

- Support the general duty officers in the key areas and at the key times

# Crime Reduction Unit

## Powers of Arrest

- A peace officer may arrest without warrant a person who has committed an indictable offence or who, on reasonable grounds, they believe has committed or is about to commit an indictable offence; a person whom they find committing a criminal offence or a person in respect of whom he has reasonable grounds to believe that a warrant of arrest or committal
- LCA (Liquor Control and Licensing Act) allows the arrest of someone who is intoxicated in public or refusing to leave a licensed establishment
